## **RAYMOND WATER SYSTEM**

In compliance with the Governor's Executive Order EO B-37-16, the California Public Utilities Commission's Resolution W-5103, and the State Water Resources Control Board's Resolution No. 2016-0029, Hillview Water has established the following water conservation measures which are effective immediately:

- ➔ Watering outdoor landscapes in a way that causes water to “runoff” onto adjacent property, non-irrigated areas, private and public walkways, roadways, parking lots, or structures is prohibited.
- ➔ Outside watering for landscape and lawn areas twice per week.
  - Watering only before dawn or after dusk.
  - Even numbered addresses water on Tuesday and Saturday.
  - Odd numbered addresses water on Wednesday and Sunday.
  - No watering on Mondays, Thursdays, and Fridays.
- ➔ Outside hand-held hoses for watering landscaping and lawn areas and washing a vehicle must have a positive shut-off valve.
  - No washing of driveways or sidewalks.
- ➔ Use of a fountain or other decorative water feature, except where the water is recirculated, is prohibited.
- ➔ Customers are not allowed to irrigate turf or ornamental landscapes during and 48 hours following measurable precipitation.
- ➔ Restaurants and other food service establishments can only serve water upon the customer's request.
- ➔ Operators of hotels and motels must offer their guests the option to not have their linens and towels laundered daily, and prominently display this option in each guest room.
- ➔ Watering landscapes of newly constructed homes and buildings in a manner inconsistent with established regulations.

Violation of any of these prohibited or restricted water use activities may be punished by a fine of up to five hundred dollars (\$500) for each day in which the violation occurs (23 CCR § 864(d)).

Please note: The Raymond water system is, currently, operating at full capacity. Please continue to conserve water and notify us immediately if you see water theft or tampering. Hillview will install water restrictors and/or lock off water services as necessary to protect the system and provide water for all our customers.
